36 Hole Stroke Play Qualifying

All Tee Times will be in the Morning

- Sign up begins on Thursday, February 20th at 7:00am by using the Golf Genius link that we will send in advance for the 2025 Ladies Club Championship.
- Cost to play is \$65.00++ per person, including dinner at the Clubhouse on Saturday, March 15th for all players. Dinner is included for all players regardless of how far they advance. This event is for members only, renters are not allowed to play.
- If a player in the event would like to bring their significant other to dinner, they must contact Alicia Rollinson at arollinson@worthingtoncc.net (space is limited). The fee is \$50.00++.
- Please do not sign up if you cannot play on all of the scheduled dates. Cancellation date is March 6 at 8:00am. Anyone on the list at that time will be billed.
- Each player must have at least 10 Worthington scores since March 8th, 2024, and an established USGA handicap to be eligible.
- There will be no Chelsea points given to participants for all rounds they qualify for.
- 36 holes of gross stroke play qualifying for all Flights will be held on Saturday, March 8th in the morning and Tuesday, March 11th in the morning. All putts must be holed in the stroke play qualifier and there is no maximum score. For the qualifying rounds in the Championship Flight and the Gold Tee Flight the drop area on hole #18 will not be used. For the qualifying rounds the drop area on hole #18 will be used for the Gold/Red and Red Flights.
- The 4 lowest gross scores in each flight will advance to match play on Thursday, March 13th in the morning and Saturday, March 15th in the morning. All players that advance to the match play portion will receive Golf Shop Sweeps. There will be consolation matches in all flights to determine 3rd place.

- Should there be a tie for the last qualifying position in any flight after round 2 all players tied will be paired together and sent back to #1 tee and play gross stroke play hole by hole until the qualifying spot(s) are filled.
- Should there be a tie between players that have qualified but tied for seeding positions (seed #1, 2, 3, etc.) will be broken by the USGA recommended system of matching cards between those players for round two using the back 9, 6, 3, 1 scores.
- If there is a rain out on any of the tournament days, we will move on to the next scheduled day with the Finals then being played on Sunday, March 16th. If there is a rainout, dinner will still be on March 15th.
- All match play rounds will be stroked off of the low ball in all flights.
- The Championship Flight is open to any player and will be played from the Gold Tees. The drop area on hole #18 will not be in use for either the Championship Flight or the Gold Tee Flight for any of the rounds of the stroke play or match play event. The 4 lowest gross scores from the Gold Tees will be the Championship Flight, the next 4 lowest gross scores will be the Gold Tee Flight. The winner of the Championship Flight Final Match will be the 2025 Worthington Ladies Club Champion. Championship Flight match play will be gross, the Gold Tee Flight match play will be net.
- The Gold/Red Flight is open to any player except those that have designated Gold Tees as their Tournament Tee (players may move back, but not up). Net scores will be used for match play and the drop area on hole #18 may be used for all rounds of the stroke play and match play event.
- The Red Flight is open to any player except those that have designated Gold Tees or Gold/Red Tees as their Tournament Tee (players may move back, but not up). Net scores will be used for match play and the drop area on hole #18 may be used for all rounds of the stroke play and match play event.
- If more than 14 players sign up for any flight except the Championship Flight, there will be multiple flights on that tee. If there are multiple flights for any one tee, the player's handicaps will determine the flights.
- The WLGA Committee and the Head Golf Professional will have final say on player's tee choice.
- All qualifying stroke play rounds will be posted by the Golf Shop in GHIN as a "C" score. Match play rounds will not be posted by the Golf Shop, but may be posted by the player if they feel they have a legitimate 18 hole score to post.
- All matches will be 18 holes of match play, if tied after 18 holes please go back to your first hole of the match and play hole by hole until there is a winner. If it is a net match, the strokes will fall as they did on the original 18.
- Scorecards should be exchanged on the first tee so that you are not keeping your own score. At the completion of play all scorecards must be signed and attested by all players before leaving the grounds.
- Any ball hit out of bounds or lost must be replayed with a 1 stroke penalty.
