Golf Course News From the Superintendent

Yesterday we received about .25" of rain, far less than what was expected last week when we were watching tropical system Sara.

Fortunately, that system fell apart as it crossed over the Yucatan peninsula. This time of year, as we head into dry season even a .25" of rain helps maintain water levels in the ground and aquifers.



Today we are replacing some of the Coco Plum along number 17 to fill in the gaps along the fence. We are using 7 gallon plants to help match them up to the existing hedge. Our hope is that by the end of next summer that hedge will be

fully established and at or about the height of the fence. It will be great once it is able so screen and hide the fence from Quail West.
