## Golf Course News From the Superintendent

If you have been around the course, you have seen cones on various cart paths. Those areas were pre-cut in preparation for today's asphalt patching. Our cart



paths continue to have areas every year that need to be patched to keep them smooth and safe so no one twists their ankle. We do the worst of the areas at the end of each year; this year in addition to any potholes we also removed the worst of the raised areas damaged by tree roots.



We are also working to complete our oak tree trimming for the year in the common grounds. Please use caution over the next few days as they work along Worthington Way trimming the oaks back away from buildings, signs, and any low hanging branches over the road.

Please remember to keep all four wheels on the cart path whenever possible and follow all directional signs. Cart traffic has picked up in

the months of November and December and with the cooler weather the ingress and egress areas of the golf course are definitely starting to show signs of wear and tear from carts. We will also be starting the Rest-A-Hole program again next week with one hole on the front and one hole on the back cart path only. The Pro Shop, Starters and Rangers will help inform you which holes are cart path only and there will be signs posted on each hole before the fairway.
