This course offers fun and challenge for any level player. The forward tees provide beautiful views and interesting shots from a yardage of 4,200. From the tips, the championship tees measure 6,800 yards and offers even more spectacular views and challenging shot locations. This course takes advantage of the existing terrain, strategically placed bunkers, attractive mounding and generous greens.

Further accolades include being voted as one of the Top 25 U.S. Golf Courses and Top 25 Best Value Golf Courses by the 2023 Golfer's Choice.



During this round, you will be able to challenge your game on this spectacular course designed by the legendary Robert Trent Jones, Sr. The multiple tee placements allow the course to play from 5,515 yards (forward tees) up to 7,000 yards (championship tees). Home to the West Virginia LPGA Classic for 11 years, many stories will return to our Southern home regaling the amazing shots and brilliant play of our Worthingtonians (as well as the humbling tales of why none of us will be on the tour any time soon).
