
I am looking forward to the coming season, if I have not met you, I hope I get to this year.

Happy New Year! Hope everyone had a Wonderful Holiday with Family and Friends. I would like to thank the Worthington members for your thoughtfulness this holiday season as you have shown overwhelming generosity in donating to the employee holiday gift fund. You truly are a blessing to the staff.

Worthington had a very good financial year as of November 30, 2024:

Clubhouse Food and Beverage YTD Revenues

better than budget by \$204,934 or 19%. **YTD positive** variance to budget by \$69.869 or 7%.

Cabana Revenues were below budget however cost of goods were favorable at 38%, the net result is a negative variance of \$54K YTD.

Combined Food and Beverage ended the year with a YTD positive variance to budget by \$15,920 or 2%.

A huge thank you Alicia, Talia, Chef Cameron, and the Staff for an excellent job this year delivering exceptional, creative successful events throughout the year.

Food and Beverage now has an exceptional Seasonal H2B staff in place, along with our full time, well trained, local staff, they are geared up and ready to execute a successful winter season for our members.

Golf operations -

Rounds of Golf Year to Year Comparison

- o YTD 2024 rounds of Golf = 42,823
- o YTD 2023 rounds of Golf = 47,703
- o Variance -4,880 > Rounds

Revenues -YTD total fees are \$128K under budget.

COG's – YTD Cost of goods and operating expenses better than budget.

Surplus/Deficit - YTD behind budget by \$83K.

However, Matt and the Pro Shop Team continue to work on strategies to increase revenues by providing special orders and offering marketing promotions. In the PGA Pass was extended in selected dates/times have been successfully implemented creating additional revenue.

Common grounds - YTD better than budget by \$13K.

Golf Course Maintenance – YTD Expenses are better than the budget by \$153K, from which \$25K potential permanent savings in payroll & benefits and \$70K-\$75K savings in leased equipment to be recognized through the end of the year.

Administration – YTD operating expenses are above budget at \$26K, primarily due to increased rates. Insurance is expected to be 8% or 36K over budget.

General Revenue – YTD is slightly better than budget due to more revenue being driven by higher interest income.

Overall Consolidated – YTD shows a positive variance of \$93,177 or 67% better than the budget.

I'd like to highlight some noteworthy events from the 2024 year.

The 2025 Budget was approved by the Master Board of Director's at their November Meeting and is now available to view or download on the WCC website.

The 5-year Capital Reserve Working Plan has been finalized to address WCC's capital needs. This plan ensures the replacement of aging equipment and addresses potential future aspirations, as Worthington celebrates 34 years.

We would like to thank David Forrey, Golf Course Superintendent, and the entire Golf Course Maintenance Team for their endless hours of hard work and dedication performing the tedious Summer Cultural Maintenance Practices

and many Projects throughout the year.

The new Worthington website was launched in October, Thank you Michelle for your many months of hard work and meeting all deadlines to have this accomplished.

Another positive change that occurred in 2024 is the promotion of Flor Nieto to the Activities and Marketing position. We are pleased to have Flor join the Administration team and are confident Flor will do a great job.

Peacock and Lewis Facilities Update:

The Facilities planning committee met on Thursday, December 12 to review the final Peacock and Lewis plan to include potentially renovating the parking lot, tennis courts, adding Pickleball courts and renovating the Cabana. The committee reviewed the plans and made a recommendation to the Master Board at the December 17th Master Board of Directors Meeting to move forward and obtain schematic drawings and firm cost estimates so the plans and costs can be presented to the Worthington Members by the end of January for a vote in February 2025. Plans are available for viewing on the Worthington Website.

- Plans will include potential renovations for the parking lot, tennis courts, addition of pickleball courts and upgrades to the Cabana.
- The proposed plans are a result of membership surveys.

Golf Maintenance Area Update:

The Design Build Committee, John Rehder, Committee Chair and members, Mike Hahn, Barry Bolek, Mike Brigante, Michael Jonas, Diane Harbor and Paula Caruso, Board Liaison, Sam Collins, Board President Doug Zinno and e-officio staff members, David Forrey, and Carol Ann Carney, conducted a thorough review of the proposals, and interviewed two Design Build contractors for the golf course maintenance area. After the interviews, the committee voted to recommend Suncoast Builders. There were four contractors that submitted a quote; however, the committee interviewed the two lowest bitters.

The Design Build committee recommended to the Master Board of Directors at their December 17th meeting to have Suncoast Builders begin the process of preparing the detailed Drawings of the golf course maintenance buildings and area to allow Worthington to obtain firm bids and present to the Worthington members within the first quarter of 2025, plans and pricing for a membership vote.

January 30th is the date of the Annual Membership Meeting, which will be held in the Clubhouse Dining Room at 2:00 p.m. There will be four Directors nominated to the Master Board, as there are four Director terms expiring, Mercedes Baumann from Wedgewood Fountains, William Domings from Amberley Court, Doug Zinno from Single Family II, and Joe Weiland from Single Family I. I would like to thank each and every one of the Directors/Officers for committing their time, service, and dedication in serving on the Master Board. It has been my pleasure to work alongside these very talented individuals for the past two years.

A reminder that In February, the Master Board of Directors will establish the 2025 Committee Chairs and members. Course Record - News from the Golf Shop

The Season is here, and it is a great time for golf at Worthington Country Club!

The best way to see what is happening in golf is to check out my weekly e-blast that is sent by Administration each Thursday. There are useful links and remember to click the "Read More" button to see everything that is going on.

I would like to welcome Preston Smith, our FGCU intern for this season. Preston is from Columbus, OH and is a sophomore this year. Stop by the Golf Shop to meet him. Welcome to our team, Preston!

We are emphasizing pace of play. The Rangers will instruct each group to keep up with the group in front of you. The first violation will result in a warning, 2nd violation will result in the PGA Pros coming out and having that group skip a hole, a 3rd violation will result in the group being asked to leave the golf course.

As you are playing golf, please be observant and obey all directional cart signs, ropes and stakes on the course. Our Golf Course Superintendent has placed these signs to direct traffic away from weak or worn areas of the course so that we may have the best playing conditions possible. One specific area where the signs are disobeyed the most often is in the fairway of hole #18. Please do not go any further than where the signs are placed. Thank you.

The driving range will be "mats only" every Sunday all year round. Range balls are available on the driving range seven days a week from 7:00am-5:00pm.

Would you like your golf scores to go down? Who wouldn't? My "Tip from the Head Golf Professional" is about alignment. It does not matter how straight you can hit the ball if you are not correctly aimed at the target. Try using a club(s) on the ground pointed at your target on the driving range. I worked for the PGA TOUR for 8 years, and I have never seen a TOUR player practice without some type of alignment aid on the ground. On the course, when you cannot use an alignment aid, try picking out something within a yard of your ball to aim towards. A divot, discolored piece

of grass, a broken tee, etc. I promise this will help your game.

To keep our Country Club atmosphere, please ensure that all golfers and their guests are always in proper golf attire on both the course and all practice areas.

If you see something going on in a golf area that you think is wrong during the hours of 7:00am-5:00pm, please let the Golf Shop at 239-495-1750 know right away. If it is after those hours, please email me at headpro@worthingtoncc.net. Please take pictures of the incident. Without pictures or a phone call it can be almost impossible to do anything about it. It takes all of us here at Worthington CC to make our community strong.

The Holidays are over, and everyone is ready to spend their winter in sunny Southwest Florida. 2024 was a great year at Worthington and I expect no less from 2025. We did a lot around the course in 24 and have just as much planned in 25. For those who have called Worthington home for many years you have seen improvements over the

past year and for those that have just moved in you are already enjoying them.

This past year we continued to focus a great deal of our time on greens; during our summer closures we worked to improve the soil conditions on our greens. We used different methods and machinery again this



summer than in previous years to better aerate our greens. This process has been necessary to improve our greens soil which had become overly organic and did not provide optimal



growing and drainage conditions for the grass. With the results of the past three years, we have been able to reduce our closures from three per summer to two this year because of the results of the hard work during the past three summers. This year the golf course will be closed once in June and once in August. We also made a few changes to the course this summer on number eighteen; reconstructing the rock wall around the greens complex and landscape improvements along the walkup behind the club house. The improvements have made a big impact on the visual appearance around eighteen green both looking out from the club house and looking into the green from eighteen approach. We also made improvements around the putting and chipping greens this summer to improve play ability and durability. The area was regraded, irrigation was improved, and the turf variety was changed to provide a practice area with the best possible conditions during the heavy use of season.

In 2025 you will see a lot of the same, we currently have a list of golf course, landscape, and other repair and improvement projects scheduled around Worthington. We are currently working on filling the holes along the North perimeter wall as well as addressing drainage and irrigation issues to maintain the grade along the wall. The wall as well as most buildings are scheduled to be cleaned and painted this year as scheduled maintenance. We are also going to be repaving cart paths in certain areas on the golf course to improve problematic areas and to improve traffic and safety coming on and off Southampton drive along number one tees. The golf course bathrooms are scheduled to be renovated during the summer golf course closures as well. We will be spending more time in the common areas this year replacing landscape lighting and fencing, along with other landscape improvements.

The 2025 season looks to be a great one and the staff at golf course maintenance cannot wait to get started. As always if you have any questions or suggestions email me or come and attend one of our greens and grounds meetings.






















Chef's Corner

6 Ingredient Corn Casserole



Prep Time: 5 mins Cook Time: 45 mins Total Time: 50 mins

Ingredients

8 ounces Jiffy Corn Muffin mix

- 15 ounces whole kernel corn (drained)
- 15 ounces creamed corn (not drained)
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1/2 cup melted butter
- 2 cups of shredded jack cheese

Directions

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. In a bowl, mix all of the ingredients together and pour into a greased 8"x8" baking pan.
- 3. Cook uncovered for 45-50 minutes or until lightly browned.

Notes

- Mix in 2 eggs this creates just a bit more of a lighter corn casserole.
- Add 1/2 to 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
 because cheese makes everything better, right?
- Add 1/4 cup to 1/2 cup sugar this of course makes it a very sweet corn casserole. If you add the eggs and sugar, it almost takes like a corn cake and could be eaten for dessert!


